

DIRECTIONS FROM SFO TO BERKELEY CAMPUS

Taxi: The taxi fare typically runs about \$85 from the SFO Airport to the Berkeley campus.

Tell the cab driver that you need to enter campus from Gayley Road, and that you want to travel along the north side on Hearst Ave to get to Gayley Road. From this direction, the turn off Gayley road is on your right. It looks like an unmarked driveway, and is situated between the Haas School of Business and the optometry school, just past the intersection with Stadium Rim Way (on your left). Follow the drive down and around to the right to the Clubs. (Please consult the Berkeley campus map as not all taxi drivers know about this entrance to campus.)

Shuttle: The Bayporter Express (<http://www.bayporter.com>) operates between SFO and Berkeley. The price is \$29 per person. Phone: 1 (877) 467-1800 Bay Area Toll Free 1 (415) 467-1800 Outside the Bay Area.

BART: The one-way fare is \$5.90. The BART station at SFO is located in the International Terminal. You can take the free AirTrain from the terminal directly to the BART station. Just follow the signs to AirTrain and board the Red Line train.

- At the BART station, take the Pittsburgh/Baypoint bound train to 12th St. Oakland City Center. The train runs every 15 minutes.
- At 12th St, cross the platform to a Richmond-bound train. The Richmond train should be waiting on the other side.
- Ride the Richmond-bound train to the Berkeley stop (also known as the Downtown Berkeley). Exit the station at Center Street.
- Walk east on Center Street for 1 block until reaching Oxford Street. You will be at the West Gate Entrance to campus.
- Once entering campus, please consult a Berkeley campus map (located on pedestals around campus) for directions on how to reach the Faculty Club or Women's Faculty Club.

DIRECTIONS FROM OAK TO BERKELEY CAMPUS

Taxi: The taxi fare typically runs about \$45 from the SFO Airport to the Berkeley campus.

Tell the cab driver that you need to enter campus from Gayley Road (beside the football stadium), and that you want to travel along the north side on Hearst Ave to get to Gayley Road. From this direction, the turn off Gayley road is on your right. It looks like an unmarked driveway, and is situated between the Haas School of Business and the optometry school, just past the intersection with Stadium Rim Way (on your left). Follow the drive down and around to the right to the Clubs. (Please consult the Berkeley campus map as not all taxi drivers know about this entrance to campus.)

Shuttle: The Bayporter Express (<http://www.bayporter.com>) operates between OAK and Berkeley. The price is \$25 per person. Phone: 1 (877) 467-1800 Bay Area Toll Free 1 (415) 467-1800 Outside the Bay Area.

BART: The one-way fare from Coliseum/Oakland Airport station to Downtown Berkeley is \$2.20. The Oakland International Airport is approximately 15 miles from UC Berkeley.

- At the Oakland airport, take the AirBart Shuttle bus to the Oakland Coliseum BART station. The bus costs \$3, payable in cash or with a \$3 BART ticket.
- Board a Richmond-bound BART train and get off at the Berkeley stop (also known as the Downtown Berkeley). Exit the station at Center Street.
- Walk east on Center Street for 1 block until reaching Oxford Street. You will be at the West Gate Entrance to campus.
- Once entering campus, please consult a Berkeley campus map (located on pedestals around campus) for directions on how to reach the Faculty Club or Women's Faculty Club.
