Trustworthy elections require keeping track of physical objects:


- Ballots, ballot boxes
- Pollbooks
- Voting equipment, including memory cards
- Poll tapes
- Absentee / provisional ballot applications
- Tally sheets
- Logs, chain of custody documents
- ...


Software independence requires physical security.

- Work in public (video stream including documents, public observers, daily doc upload, live-key data, no "backroom")
- Inventory materials (boxes, equipment, envelopes, forms, ...)
- Preserve evidence (chain of custody, high-resolution reference scans, image drives/memory)
- Serialize ballots
- Use accountable materials (serialize counting sheets, scan sheets, ...)
- Use activity logs (which batches have been scanned, counted, ...)
- Use methods that catch & correct error (redundant, multi-person counting teams; double-key all data entry; accountable materials)
- Take time to answer public questions
